Split in ring. 2a Plaited, 2b Unplaited.
- CLASS 3 - IN HAND COLOURED – For Skewbald and Piebald horses and ponies only.**
- CLASS 4 - IN HAND ODD COLOURED – For Palominos, Duns, Appaloosas, Roans, Spots, Paints, Creams – All Heights.**
- CLASS 5 - IN HAND DRIVING TYPE – For Horses and Ponies to make good driving types.**
- CLASS 6A - IN HAND VETERAN - 15YRS – 20YRS**

CLASS 19 - LEAD REIN – PLAITED/UNPLAITED – This is open for ponies not exceeding 12hh and lead rein must be attached to the noseband. Snaffle Only. **CLASS WILL NOT BE SPLIT.**

CLASS 20 - FIRST RIDDEN – PLAITED/UNPLAITED – This is open for ponies not exceeding 12.2hh. No cantering altogether. **CLASS WILL NOT BE SPLIT**

CLASS 21 - BEST RIDER – 16YRS & UNDER – No lead Reins – Horses and Ponies of all types.

CLASS 22 - CHAMPIONSHIP FOR CLASSES – 18, 19, 20 & 21.

CLASS 23 - FAMILY HORSE/PONY – (exceeding 13hh) to be ridden in a Snaffle Bridle

CLASS 24 - NOVICE RIDER – HORSE/PONY – For novice riders who have never won a showing class.

CLASS 25 - NOVICE RIDDEN – HORSE/PONY – For horses/ponies not to have won a showing class.

CLASS 26 - SHOW HUNTER PONY – Open to ponies exceeding 122cm but not exceeding 153cm

CLASS 27 - SHOW PONY – Open to ponies exceeding 122cm nut not exceeding 148cm.

CLASS 28 - CHAMPIONSHIP FOR CLASSES – 23, 24, 25, 26 & 27.

CLASS 29 - IN HAND FOREIGN BREEDS/WORLD BREEDS – For Andalusians, Lusitanos, Friesians, Lipizzaners, Quarter Horses, Saddlebreds, Morgans, Paints, Paso Finos, Knabstruppers, Haflingers, Mustangs and Appaloosas.

CLASS 30 - IN HAND RIDING HORSE/PONY - Of Riding Horse Type.

CLASS 31 - IN HAND WARBLOODS – Full and Part bred Warmbloods

CLASS 32 - IN HAND HUNTER HORSE/PONY

CLASS 33 - IN HAND BRED & PART BRED ARABS.

CLASS 34 - CHAMPIONSHIP FOR CLASSES – 29, 30, 31, 32 & 33.

CLASS 35 - RIDDEN FOREIGN BREEDS - For Andalusians, Lusitanos, Lipizzaners, Quarter Horses, Saddlebreds, Morgans, Paints, Paso Finos, Knabstruppers, Haflingers, Mustangs and Appaloosas.

CLASS 36 - RIDDEN WARBLOODS

CLASS 37 - RIDDEN BRED & PART BRED ARABS

CLASS 38 - RETRAINED RACEHORSE – Thoroughbreds retired from racing & now retrained. Horses must be over 15hh.

CLASS 39 - CHAMPIONSHIP FOR CLASSES – 35, 36, 37 & 38.

CLASS 40A - STYLE AND PERFORMANCE – 16 YRS & YOUNGER – All types of Pony and Horse * See rules at the end of Schedule.

CLASS 40B - STYLE AND PERFORMANCE – 17 YRS + All types of Pony and Horse * See rules at the end of Schedule.

CLASS 41 - CHAMPIONSHIP FOR CLASSES – 40A & 40B.

RING – (46m x 60m Sand & Fibre Surface) Judges Mrs J Barton and Miss L Barton

CLASS 42 - NURSERY STAKES – Ponies not to exceed 133cm – jumps not to exceed 1'9.

CLASS 44A - M & M WORKING HUNTER PONY – SMALL BREEDS.

Ponies not exceed 138cm – Jumps not to exceed 2'3

CLASS 44B - M & M WORKING HUNTER PONY – LARGE BREEDS.

Ponies all exceeding 138cm – Jumps not to exceed 2'6.

CLASS 45 - NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY

CLASS 46 - WORKING HUNTER PONY.

See * Note and the end of schedule.

Ponies up to 148cm – all ages of rider. 2'3" max height of fences

Judge will take height of pony and age of rider into consideration.

CLASS 47 - CHAMPIONSHIP FOR CLASSES – 42, 44A, 44B, 45 & 46.

CLASS 48 - NOVICE WORKING HUNTER – HUNTER TYPE

(Fences will be 2'3 -2'6) for horses that have not won a 2'6 course or above.

CLASS 49 - WORKING HUNTER HORSE – HUNTER TYPE (Fences will be 2'9 – 3') for horses that exceed 148cm.

CLASS 49B - CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE – RIDDEN

ENTRY £10 PER HORSE/PONY - WALK & TROT ONLY

CLASS 50 - CHAMPIONSHIP FOR CLASSES –48 & 49.

CLASS 51 - IN HAND LARGE M&M – Registered for Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest and Welsh sections C & D.

CLASS 52 - IN HAND SMALL M&M – Registered for Shetlands, Miniature Shetlands, Exmoor, Dartmoor and Welsh sections A & B.

CLASS 53 - IN HAND M&M UNREGISTERED & PART BRED

CLASS 54 - CHAMPIONSHIP FOR CLASSES – 51, 52 & 53.

- CLASS 55 - RIDDEN PONY CLUB PONY** – Not exceeding 138cm – Snaffle Bridle
- CLASS 56A - RIDDEN RIDING CLUB PONY** – Exceeding 138cm BUT not exceeding 153cm – Snaffle Bridle
- CLASS 56B - RIDDEN RIDING CLUB HORSE** – For Horses 15hh and over.
(No jumps)
- CLASS 57 - CHAMPIONSHIP FOR CLASSES – 55, 56A & 56B.**
- CLASS 58 - RIDDEN M&M LARGE** – Registered for Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest and Welsh sections C & D. Lead Reins not allowed

RULES FOR WORKING HUNTER HORSE AND PONY

Note: Protective boots or bandages may be worn for the jumping phase but must be removed for the showing phase. No other change of tack or rider is permitted. Martingales may be worn. Body protectors will be permitted during

*the jumping phase. A fall of horse or rider will result in elimination on medical grounds. Class to be judged 60% jumping, 40% conformation and **

Rules for Style and Performance

All sections to be judged 40% turnout of horse/pony and rider (total 40 marks), 60% for a freestyle show to be performed in an area approx. 20m x 40m

The individual show should be short and flowing. Please note, dressage whips are not permitted and children are not allowed to wear spurs.

The tack and turnout of the horse/pony should be appropriate to the type of horse/pony being presented.

The rider should dress appropriately for the type of horse/pony being presented.

Dress code as per affiliated showing classes does not have to be strictly adhered to - the overall impression is of most importance.

DRESS CODE FOR SUPREME CHAMPS

Evening performance wear is permitted. Any top hats worn must be by riders over 16 and sign a form at the Secretary BEFORE entering the ring. You will NOT be allowed in without it. This is applicable to both in hand and ridden. Wear as much bling as you like.

The Concours d'Elegance class at the Championships can be either Historical Dress or Traditional, just NO fancy dress or ball gowns
